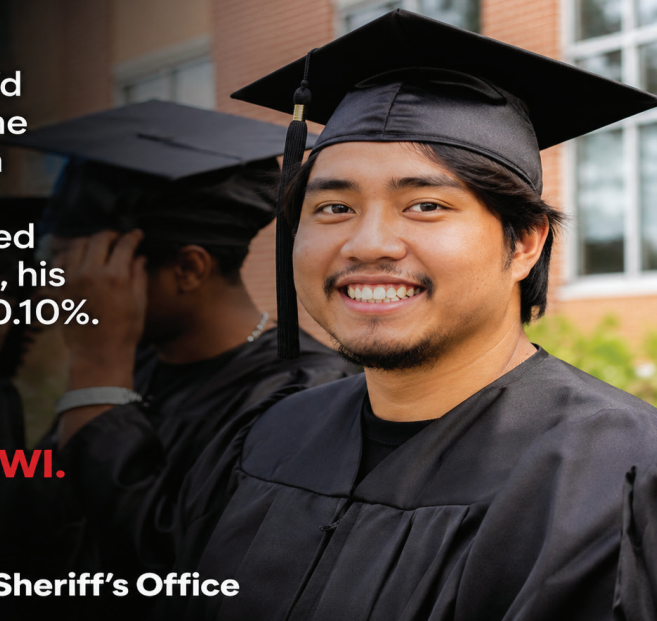

Caroline will be attending Nazareth University to continue her basketball career and major in nursing.

This year, Will received the IAC Character Counts award, given to one male and female from each school who has showcased outstanding leadership and character on and off the field. Will also stands out in the classroom with a 98 average and is a member of the National Honor Society. He also received his New York State Seal of Biliteracy and is a senior class officer as vice president. Outside of school, Will is part of an elite travel hockey team and is very involved in the community. Will will be attending Hamilton College in the fall.



# Girls Coach of the Year



## PAM QUINLAN, CANDOR COYOTES

Following up a state title is always a tough follow to act. But Candor volleyball made it look easy this fall, making it back to the state championship once again under Pam Quinlan. With a dominant regular season in which they only lost one match, the Coyotes won the IAC South Small Division for the 15th time under Quinlan. They then swept Newfield in the IAC championship to deliver Quinlan her ninth league crown. The good times kept rolling in the Section IV Class D tournament, where they faced off against Newfield in the final. The Coyotes once more took down the Trojans in straight sets to three-peat as champions and make it 14 sectional titles for Quinlan. In the New York State tournament, Candor continued to roll by sweeping Tupper Lake to win their 11th regional title and make it back to Glens Falls for the Final Four. The Coyotes made it out of pool play and back into the championship match against York. While they came up just shy of repeating as state champions, it was another phenomenal season for the Coyotes. Candor finished the season with a 16-2 record and had four players make the All-State team. Quinlan was named as the All-Tioga County Coach of the Year.

# Boys Coach of the Year



## AUBREY BROWN, MARATHON OLYMPIANS

Marathon has prided itself on producing a strong boys soccer team every time the fall season rolls around. This year was no exception. The Olympians steamrolled through the regular season with a 14-0-1 record en route to repeating as IAC North Small Division champions. The postseason began with a rematch against Odessa-Montour for the IAC Small School championship, where the Olympians blanked the Grizzlies 3-0 to successfully defend their title. In the Section IV Class C tournament, Marathon first took down division foes Southern Cayuga 2-0 in the quarterfinals followed by 1-0 win in double overtime over Trumansburg to punch its ticket to the championship. In the final, 110 minutes could not separate the Olympians and Seton Catholic, meaning both teams were crowned co-champions. Although the Saints advanced to the New York State Tournament on penalty kicks, Marathon won its first sectional title since 2019. The Olympians high-flying attack, scoring 94 goals and averaging close to five goals per game, was complemented by a near-impenetrable defense, allowing only four goals the entire campaign and keeping 16 shutouts. Two players earned All-State honors, while Brown was named the IAC Chris Bond Coach of the Year.

## RACHEL VICKIO, WATKINS GLEN LAKE HAWKS

Rachel Vickio closed out her illustrious three-sport career at Watkins Glen with more of what she's been accustomed to: winning. In the fall, Rachel helped girls soccer win the IAC Large School title and made it all the way to the Section IV Class B championship game. She played in a new role this year, moving up from the defense to the midfield. It was business as usual for Rachel, earning IAC Second Team All-Star honors. Rachel ends her soccer career as a two-time Section IV champion, three-time IAC champion and a three-time IAC All-Star. In the winter, Rachel had a milestone campaign for girls basketball, surpassing 1,000 career points and being named to the Class B All-State Fourth Team. Rachel guided the Lake Hawks to a second consecutive IAC Large School championship and a Section IV Class B semifinal appearance. In total, she was a four-time IAC All-Star and a two-time All-State selection. In the spring for outdoor track and field, Rachel specialized in the discus throw to great effect. She won the IAC Large School title in the event and placed third at the Section IV Class C championships. Of her three sports, Rachel will continue her basketball career at Elmira College while majoring in nursing.

## TRENT THIBAULT, LANSING BOBCATS

Trent Thibault has made an indelible mark in both Lansing and in Section IV as one of the best long-distance runners that the area has ever seen. Trent began his final school year with a bang during the cross country season. It was more of the same mastery out on the course, winning his third career IAC and Section IV titles. But it was at the state meet where he shined the brightest, bringing home the Class C state title. For his efforts, Trent was named to the Class C All-State First Team. In the winter, Trent maintained his long-distance domination by winning the Section IV Class C/D title in the 1,600-meter and 3,200-meter runs. He qualified for states in the 3,200-meter run, finishing in 10th place. The outdoor season was just as fruitful, as he claimed victory in the 1,600-meter and 3,200-meter runs at both IACs and sectionals. Trent will continue both his cross country and track and field careers at Columbia University and will major in financial economics.

## **Male and Female Scholar-Athletes of the Year**

Each award winner has been recognized as a top varsity performer in at least two sports while maintaining a minimum grade average of 85 with no disciplinary issues.

The scholar-athlete must be a high school senior, with strong academic and civic contributions.

## **Outstanding Scholar-Athletes**

Each award winner has been recognized as a top varsity performer in their respective sport, while maintaining a minimum grade average of 80, with no disciplinary issues.

## **Outstanding Coaches and Coach of the Year**

Each award winner has been recognized as a top varsity head coach for their sport for the entire season and is in good standing with their school and Section IV Athletics.
